

Eligibility criteria

- Applicants must be specialists, trainees or junior doctors with a declared intention of specialising in a sub-specialty of surgical oncology.
 - Applicants must be members of ESSO at the time they submit their application.
 - Applicants must be 40 years old or younger
 - The institution to be visited must be located in a country other than the applicant's current country. European applicants may choose to visit European or non-European units, while non-European applicants must choose to visit an European centre.
 - Previous Educational Grants recipients will be ineligible to apply for a second award.
- The training period should occur within one year following the aware notification

Documents to provide

Applications must be submitted in English only and include the following information:

- a short CV (2 pages maximum)
- a motivation letter including the oncology background, specific objectives, plans after the visit (max 1 page)
- a letter of support from the Head of Department or mentor
- a letter of invitation from the Head of the Department they wish to visit.

At the end of the fellowship

At the end of the fellowship, fellows will be asked to

- produce a complete report on their fellowship and make it available for the ESSO newsletter or social media
- commit to attend one of the two coming ESSO annual meetings where they will present their fellowship experience.
