What can we do for you

We provide you with the opportunity to participate in The European Peritoneal Surface Oncology Training Programme, a high quality, structured, basic and advanced training that will lead you to The European Certification on Peritoneal Surface Oncology.



The European Peritoneal Surface Oncology Training

Programme includes the following mandatory educational activities:

Clinical training at one of the established PSO Treatment programmes recognised by PSOGI

- Observation of Cytoreductive Surgery and HIPEC procedures.
- Direct participation in the execution of Cytoreductive Surgery and HIPEC procedures from anesthesia induction to patient leaving the operating room.
- Participation and attendance to ad hoc multidisciplinary conferences ("tumour board") for presentation, discussion patient selection and therapeutic decisionmaking.
- Presence in in-hospital postoperative follow up.

Attendance to two ESSO Advanced courses in Peritoneal Surface Oncology

- A hands-on course with practice of cytoreductive surgery and HIPEC in a veterinary lab, including practical case-discussions, tips and tricks and videos. This course takes place once a year.
- A theoretical course dealing with the scientific basis and current multidiscipli-nary practice of Peritoneal Surface Oncology, run biannually at rotating sites. This course takes place every two years.

Attendance to two Peritoneal Surface Oncology Congresses

- At least one PSOGI World Congress (biannual)
- One national PSO congress, recognised by PSOGI

Formulation and elaboration of a research project

 Under the supervision of an established programme recognised by PSOGI, to be presented at a congress and submitted for publication at a peer-reviewed journal. This project may evolve into a thesis.

A tutor/mentor will be assigned to you for guidance, tutoring and planning of your training activities throughout the progamme.
